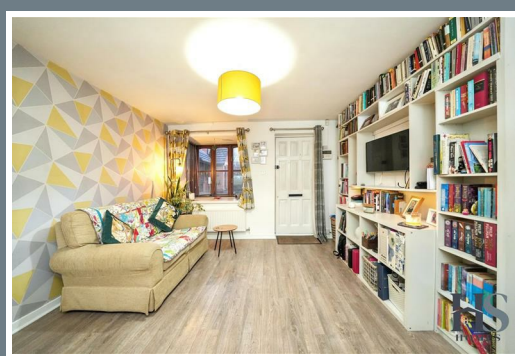

The property benefits from an allocated parking space and access to a well-maintained communal garden area. The frontage is neat and tidy, offering an inviting first impression.

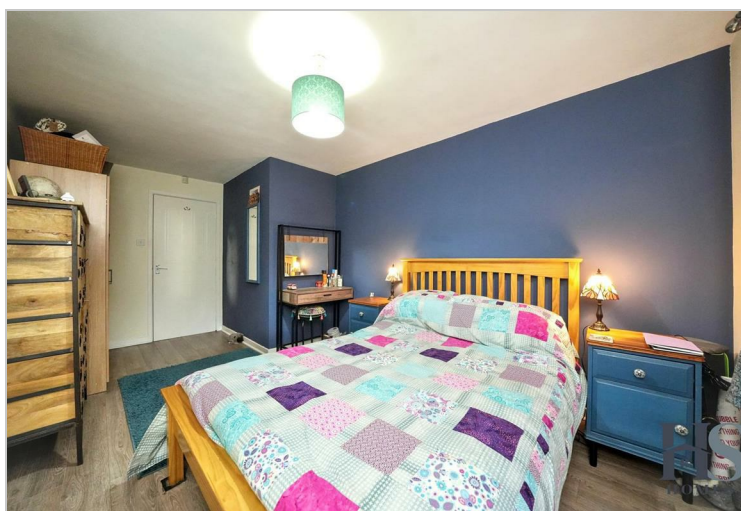
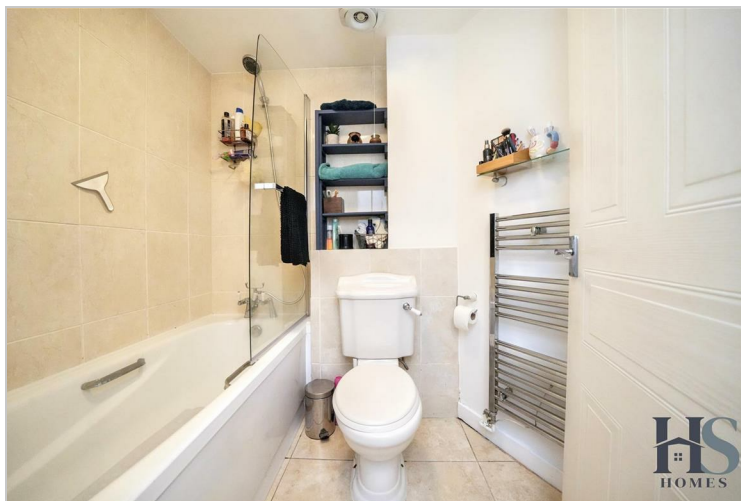

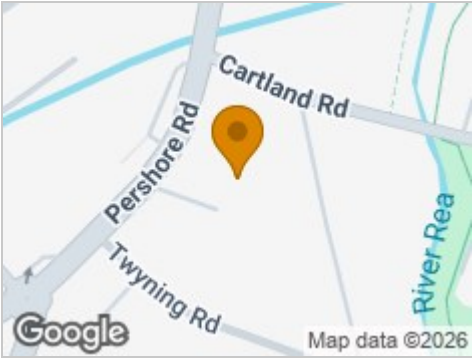

Road Map



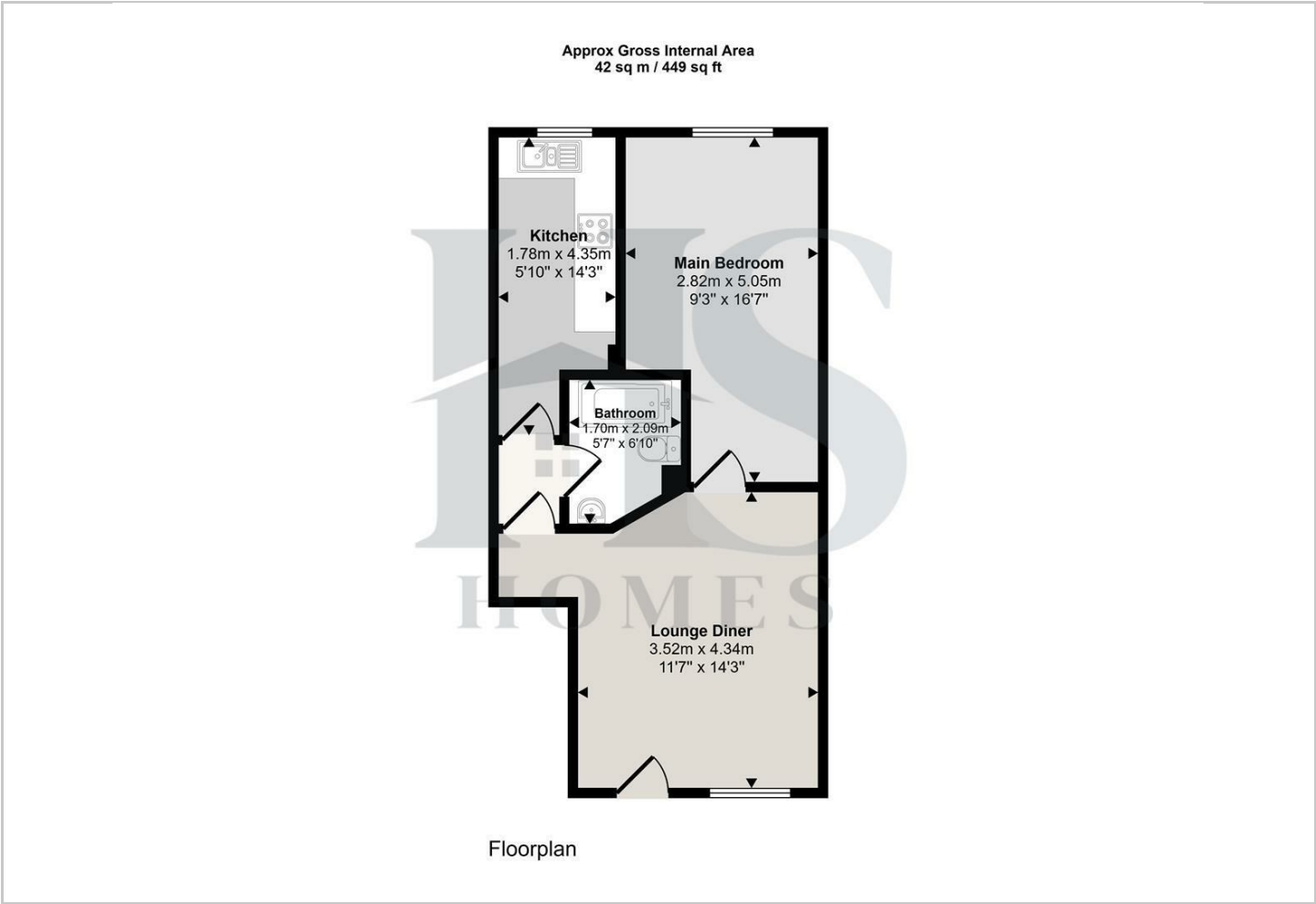
Hybrid Map



Terrain Map



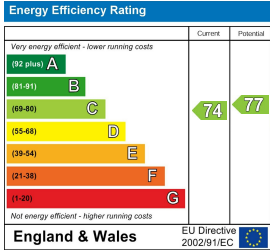
Floor Plan
