DESCRIPTION

This delightful end terrace house incorporates uPVC double glazing and electric wall heaters and offers two bedroom accommodation comprising;

ENTRANCE HALL

5'9" x 14'1"

uPVC entrance door. Stair way leading to the first floor. Under stairs storage cupboard. Coving to the ceiling. Wall mounted gas heater.

LOUNGE

9'4" x 16'0"

Bow window. A cream fire surround with matching hearth housing a gas fire. Coving to the ceiling.

DINING KITCHEN

9'1" x 15'8" max.

A range of fitted base and wall units with laminated worktops and tiled surrounds. the units incorporate a stainless steel single drainer sink. Plumbing for an automatic washing machine. Wall mounted gas heater. uPVC door leads into the rear garden.

LANDING

Airing cupboard housing the hot water cylinder. Loft access. Coving to the ceiling.

BEDROOM ONE

To the front elevation. Over stairs storage cupboard. Coving to the ceiling. Wall mounted electric heater.

BEDROOM TWO

9'3" x 13'4"

To the rear elevation. Recessed wardrobe with sliding doors. Coving to the ceiling. Wall mounted electric heater.

BATHROOM

5'6" x 6'2"

A coloured suite comprising a panelled bath with an electric shower over, a pedestal wash hand basin and a low flush WC. Tiled walls. Coving to the ceiling.

STORE

6'10" x 7'2"

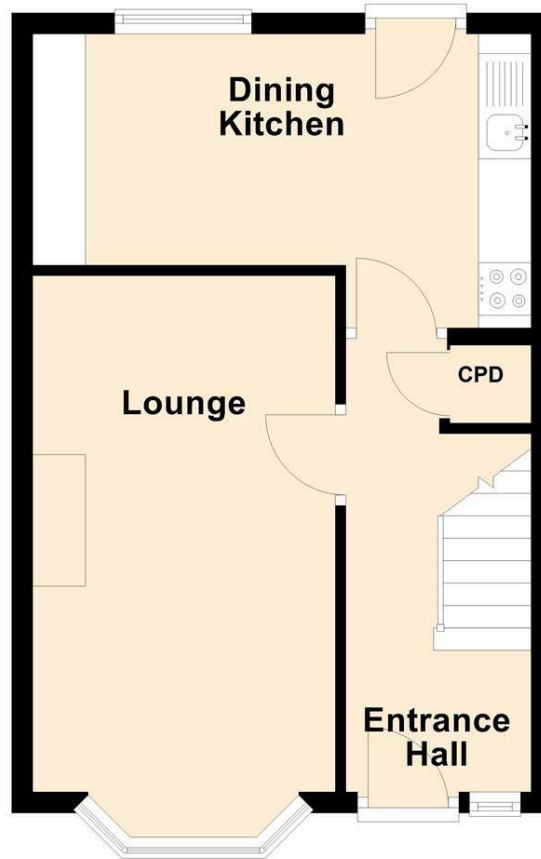
Brick built store with light and power.

GARDENS

To the front of the property the garden is enclosed by a brick garden wall and a metal gate. The garden itself is laid to gravel with planted borders. A paved pathway provides access to the front entrance door and extends along the side of the property into the rear garden.
