Constructed in 2015 by Cripps Builders. This well appointed property offers accommodation including an entrance hall, 'L' shaped lounge/diner, kitchen, three bedrooms, master ensuite, and bathroom.

The property offers uPVC sealed unit double glazed windows, under floor heating via an air source heat pump, driveway parking, garage and nicely enclosed rear garden. Now offered with no onward chain, early internal viewing is highly recommended.



Entrance Hall

Part-obscure glazed entrance door, loft access, airing cupboard housing pressurised hot water cylinder, controls for under-floor heating, thermostat, power points, doors leading off

Lounge / Dining Room 21'3" max reducing to 12'7" x 15'1" max reducing † (6.50m max reducing to 3.86m x 4.61m max reducing †)

A spacious 'L' shaped room with window and glazed sliding doors facing the rear garden, power points, television point, telephone point, thermostat control for under-floor heating

Kitchen 10'11" x 8'3" (3.34m x 2.54m)

Window to side aspect, part-glazed door to side a range of fitted kitchen units, with rolled edge work surface and tiled splashback, stainless steel sink drainer with monobloc tap, integrated electric oven, ceramic hob, stainless steel chimney style extractor, dishwasher and fridge/freezer. Thermostat for under-floor heating.





Bedroom 1 12'7" reducing to 9'10" x 10'4" (3.85m reducing to 3m x 3.17m)

Window to front aspect, built-in wardrobe, thermostat control for under floor heating, power points, television point, door giving access to

Side facing obscure glazed window, low level WC, tiled shower cubicle, pedestal hand wash basin with tiled splashback, inset LED ceiling lighting, ventilation, illuminated mirror

Bedroom 2 12'7" x 8'7" increasing to 10'9" (3.85m x 2.64m increasing to 3.28m)

Window to front aspect, built-in wardrobe, power points, television point, thermostat for under-floor heating, telephone point

Bedroom 3 10'1" x 8'11" (3.09m x 2.72m)

Window to side aspect, power points, telephone point, television point, thermostat control

Directions

On arriving in the village of Martham on the Rollesby Road, turn right at the 'T' junction with Repps Road, continue through the centre of the village passing through The Green, turn right heading towards Hemsby, turn right into Hall Road, turn right into Walnut Tree Avenue, continue as the road bears to the left, turn right into Sycamore Avenue, then right into Alder Avenue, where the property can be found a short way along on the lefthand side.

The property is located in a desirable position with vehicular access via a brickweave driveway, extending to the side of the property leading onto garage. There's a nicely enclosed rear garden, mainly paved and shingled with mature fruit tree planting, an area of artificial grass, pond, and close board panelled fencing to boundaries.

Location

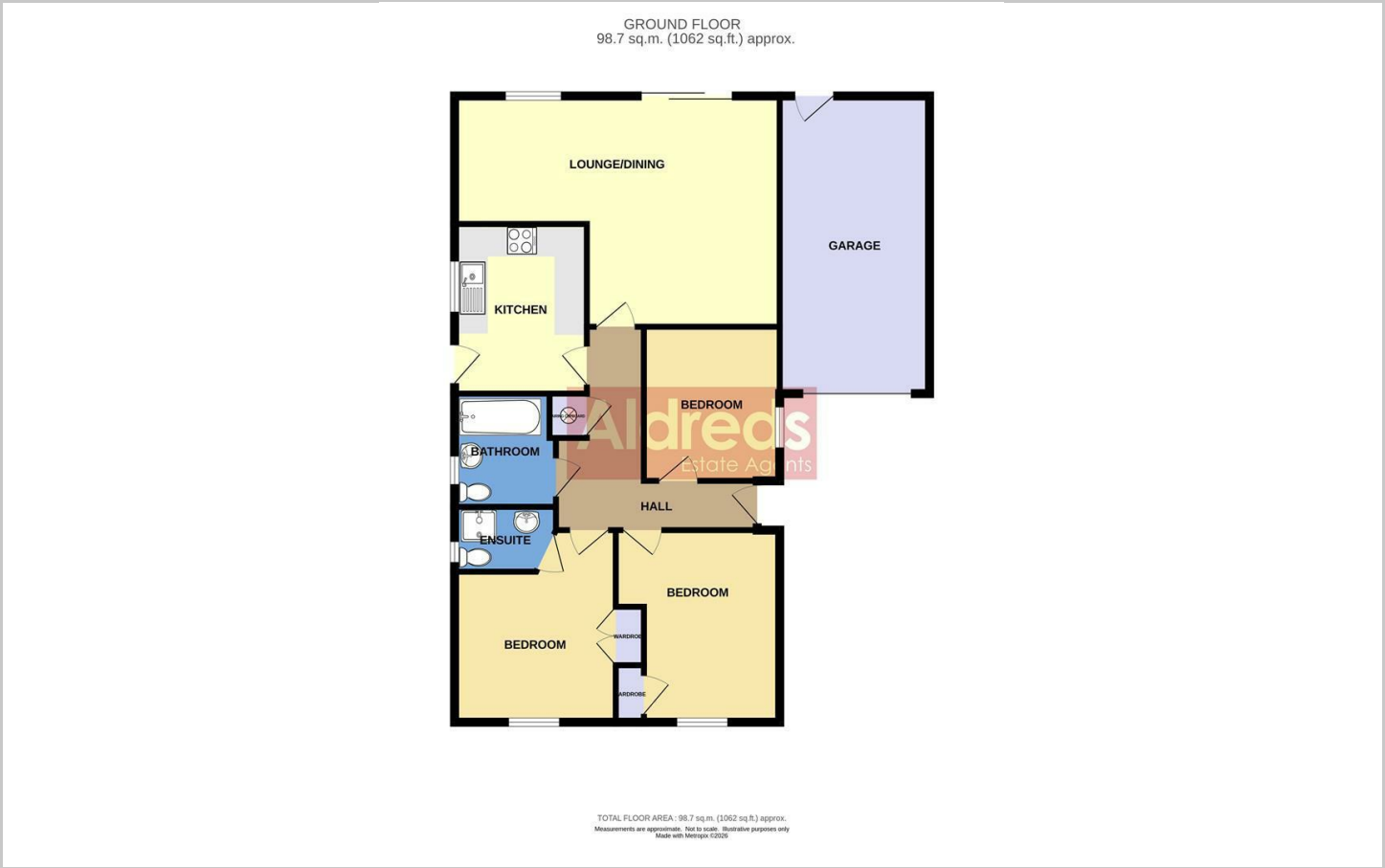

Floor Plans

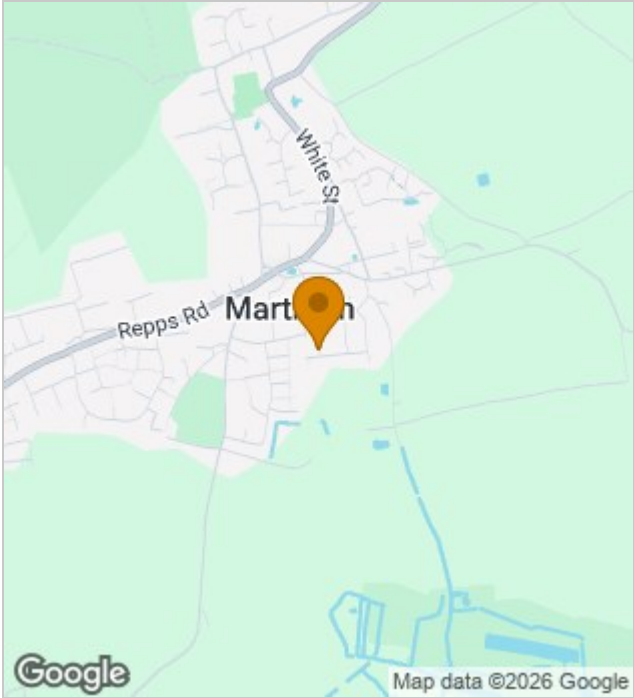
