The Location



The property has been recently redecorated to a tasteful neutral theme throughout and benefits from a Worcester Bosch combination boiler, uPVC double glazing and recently refitted carpets.

Upon entering through a uPVC double glazed door into the hallway with coving and feature archway. The hallway provides access to a reception room/ground floor bedroom, spacious lounge and door with access to steps leading down to the cellar. The lounge, located at the rear of the home, features a recessed fireplace with stainless steel back and gas coal-effect fire, complemented by French doors to the garden, a wooden picture rail and central heating radiator, creating a warm and inviting living space.

The well-appointed kitchen is finished with white high-gloss units, brushed steel handles and granite-effect worktops. It includes a stainless steel sink with mixer tap, electric oven with gas hob, and ceramic tiling throughout. There's also dedicated space for a washing machine and fridge (appliances available by separate negotiation) with rear garden access via a convenient side door. The kitchen also has doorway access to a shared passageway leading to Arthur Street.

Upstairs, the first floor offers two further spacious double bedrooms—one with a built-in wardrobe and rear-facing window, the other with coving ceiling and wooden picture rail—alongside a bathroom featuring a white three piece suite with chrome fittings, Triton shower over the bath, and grey wood-effect flooring. There are stairs from the first floor landing leading to the second floor and a spacious attic bedroom with eaves storage, and a rear-facing double-glazed velux style window.

Externally, the rear garden includes a paved path, patio seating area and lawn, all enclosed by fencing and walling for privacy.










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The Location
