Offering spacious accommodation of approximately 1,200 sq ft across four floors, the property would ideally suit a first-time buyer or young professionals, and enjoys a highly convenient location close to open countryside and Codnor Park Reservoir.

The property benefits from gas central heating and briefly comprises: a lower ground floor entrance hall, dining room with open-plan access to a characterful kitchen area, together with useful storage space. At ground floor level there is a spacious lounge featuring a fireplace with log burner, with stairs leading to the first-floor sitting room and a generously sized bathroom. The second floor offers two well-proportioned bedrooms enjoying far-reaching views.

Externally, the property benefits from a gravelled parking space to the front.

Codnor Park and Ironville are popular Derbyshire villages offering a blend of countryside surroundings, local heritage, and excellent commuter links. Situated close to Ripley and Heanor, the area provides a range of everyday amenities including shops, schools, pubs, and leisure facilities, while also benefiting from nearby access to beautiful open countryside and walking routes around Codnor Castle and Butterley Reservoir.
