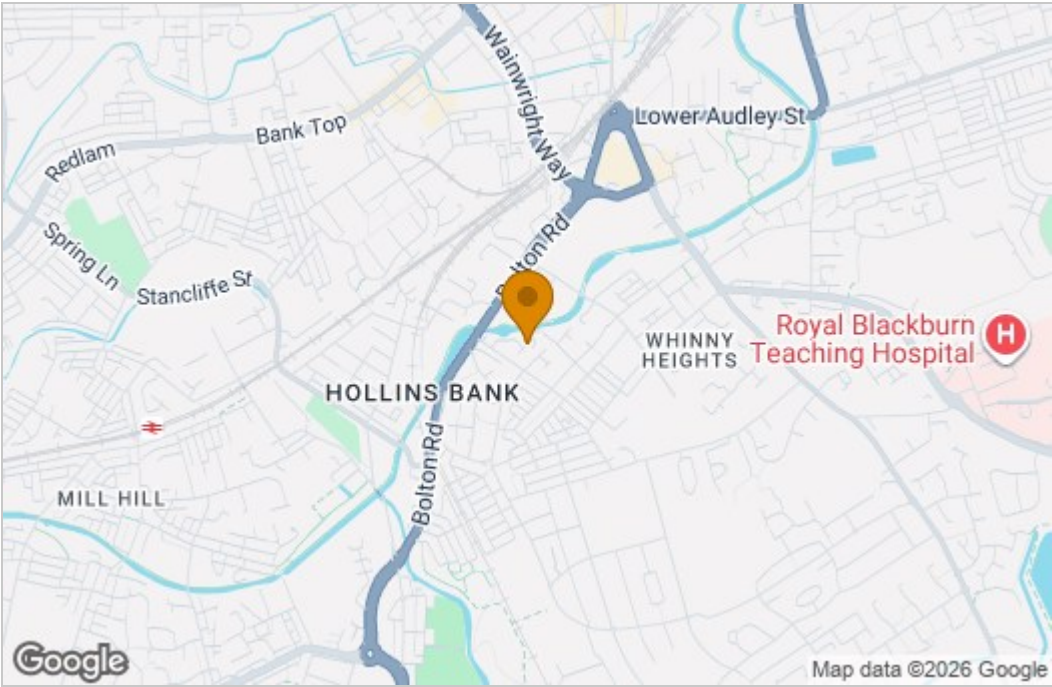

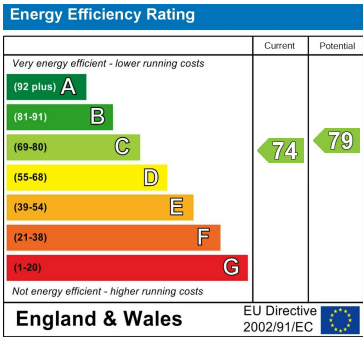


Floor Plan
