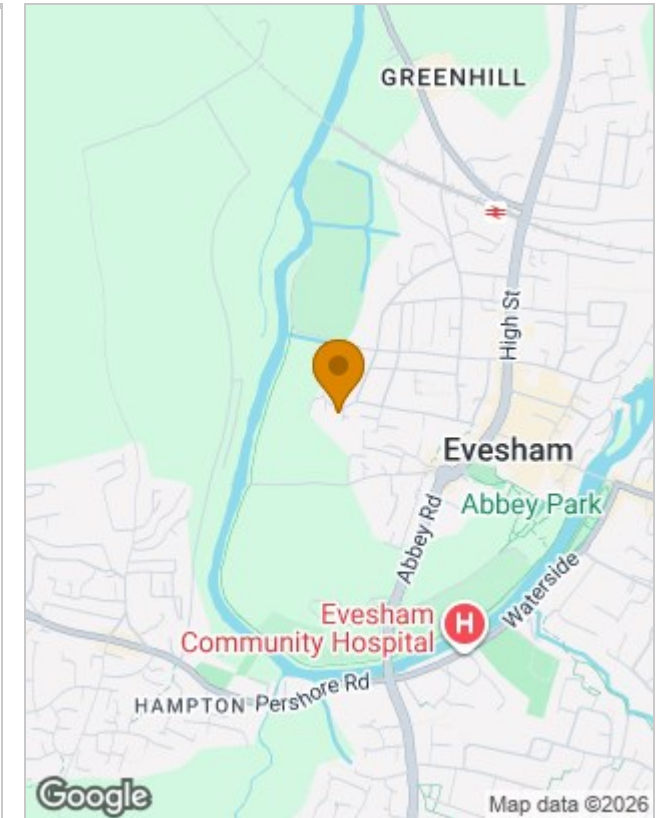

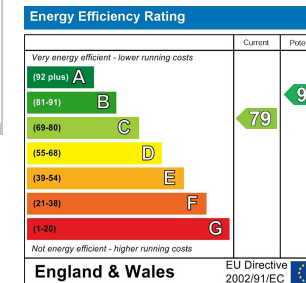
Floor Plans
