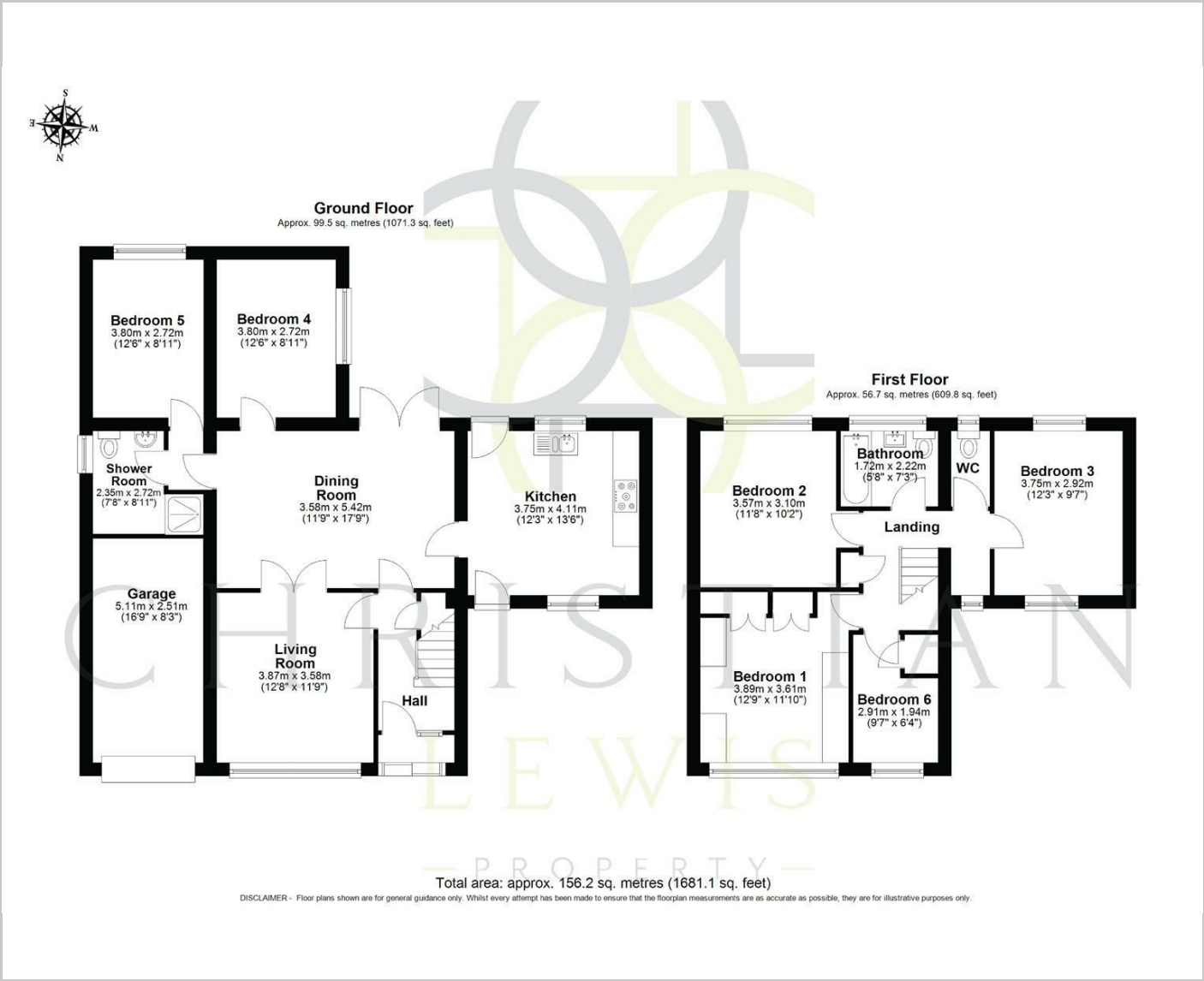

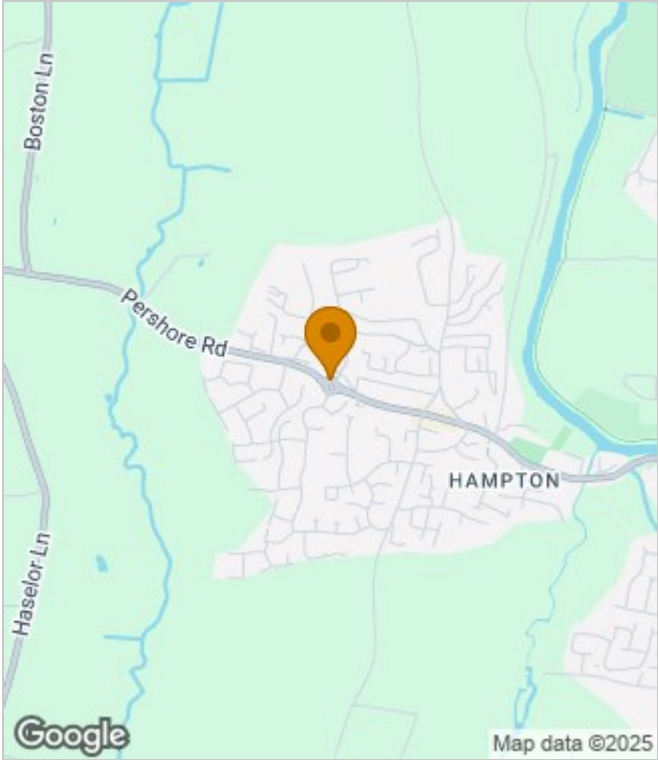

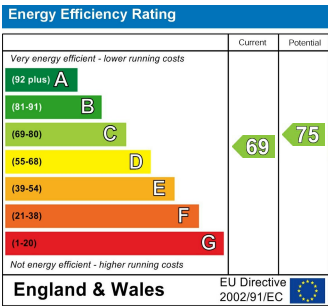
Floor Plans
