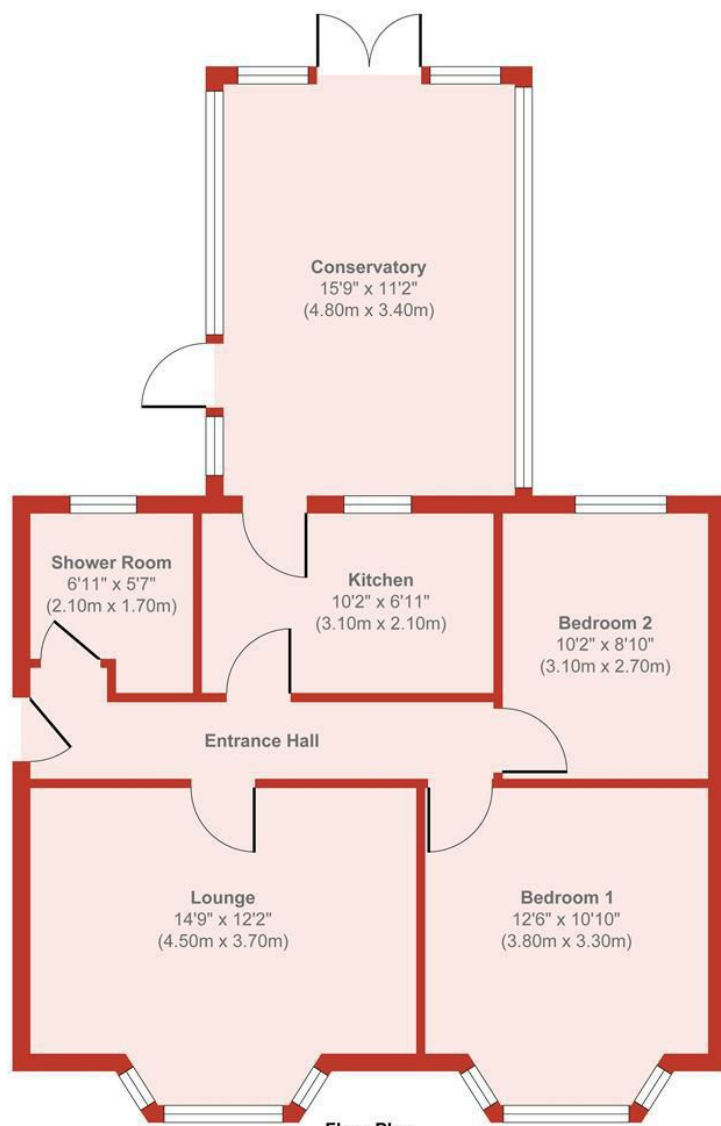

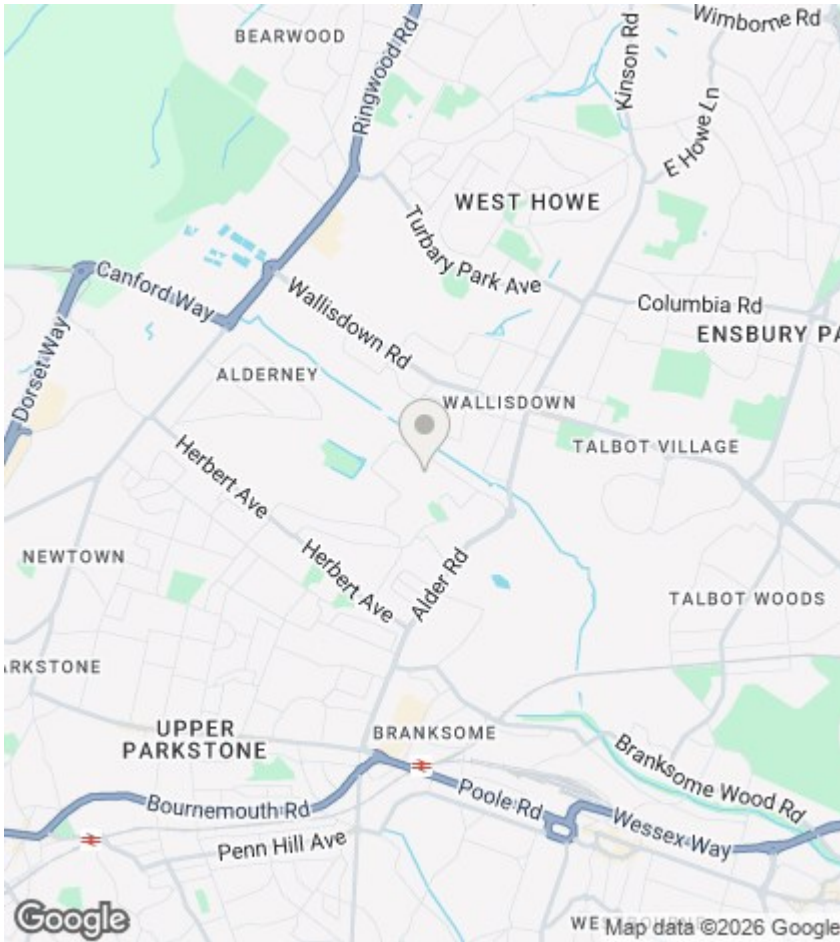


Floor Plan
