Floor Plan



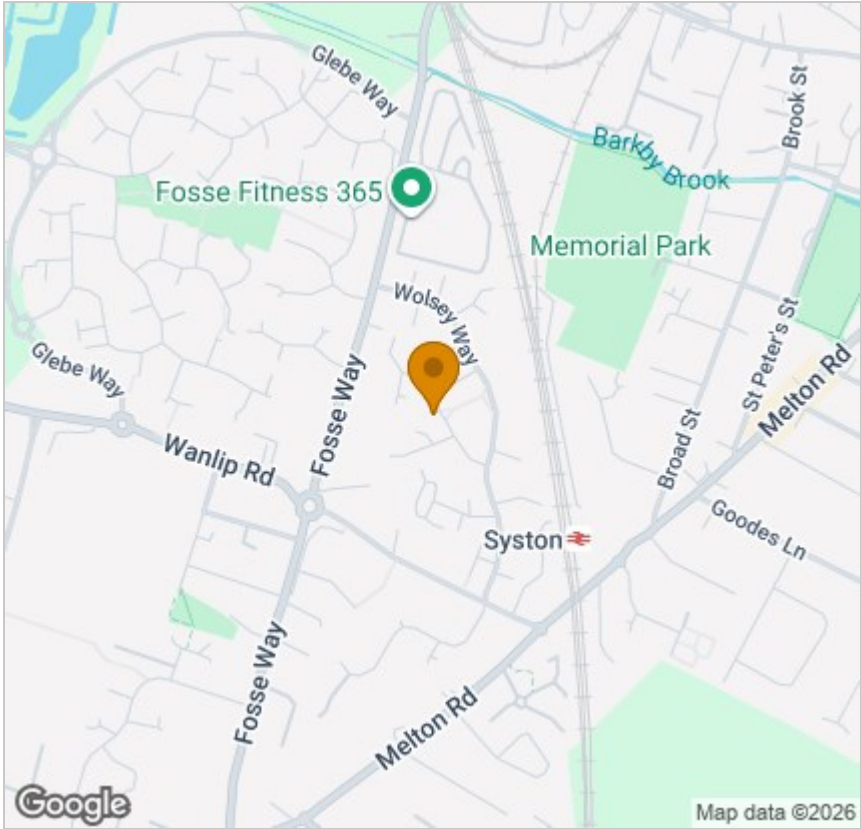
