

From the main A34 Abingdon junction proceed into Abingdon along Ock Street bearing sharp left at the traffic lights and continue to the next Vineyard / Stert Street traffic lights and bear right to Stert Street. Towards the end of Stert Street, just after the archway beyond Pizza Express, you will find the 5-7 Stert Street with its red front entrance door.
