




Stepstone House Old Moor, Abingdon, OX14 4ED

DIRECTIONS: From Oxford take the A34 South and come off at the Milton junction, signposted Didcot, Milton, Wantage. At the roundabout take the first exit to Milton and then first left after about 450m to Milton village. After about 400 metres turn right into School Lane before the sign to Milton Manor and the Plum Pudding Inn. After 175m the recreation ground will be on your right hand side and as the road becomes Old Moor, Stepstone House will be the second property on your right.
